CIRCULAR TO BASKETBALL COACHES / MANAGEMENT OF BASKETBALL TEAMS

Dear Sir / Madam

**QUALIFIED COACHES FOR NATIONAL BASKETBALL LEAGUE DIVISION 1 & 2
AND WOMEN NATIONAL BASKETBALL LEAGUE**

- The Coaching & Development Committee of the Basketball Association of Singapore has formulated a set of new provisions governing the roles of coaches who are coaching teams in the above mentioned tournaments, as part of its continued efforts to raise the standard of coaching and level of performance of basketball in Singapore.
- The Management Committee of the Basketball Association of Singapore has approved of the new ruling for implementation.
- The effective date for implementation would be in January 2010.
- For easy reference, a summary of the details of the provisions is given in the attached Annex A.
- The details of the NCAP courses that are available and conducted at SSC and BAS for 2009 are given in the attached Annex B.

SUMMARY OF DETAILS OF THE PROVISIONS (ANNEX A)

- ❖ **All coaches coaching teams in NBL Division 1, NBL Division 2 & Women NBL are to have National Registry of Coaches (NROC) Level 2, registered with the Singapore Sports Council (SSC). This would include minimally attaining NCAP Level 2 (Theory), NCAP Level 2 (Technical) & First-Aid certification.**

- ❖ **The SSC NROC website is <http://coaches.ssc.gov.sg/publish/Coaches/home.html>**

- ❖ **Coaches without the required coaching qualifications are not allowed to coach any teams in the tournament.**

- ❖ **All coaches must furnish their original coaching qualifications for photocopying and verification purposes upon registration for the tournament.**

- ❖ **All coaches must indicate their coaching level upon registration for the tournament (e.g. Theory Level _____, Technical Level _____, First-Aid (Yes/No)). There would be some modifications on the registration form.**

- ❖ **There will not be a ‘player cum coach cum referee’ scenario. This would only be applied to an individual tournament to allow the affected personnel to choose to be either a player, or a coach, or a referee for that particular tournament.**

- ❖ **All coaches must be in proper attire (shoes) during the tournament. In the aspect of attire, club-tee or polo-tee is encouraged.**

- ❖ **When registering for a particular tournament, a team is allowed to register up to 1 Head Coach and 3 Assistant Coaches. The Assistant Coach should also possess the necessary coaching qualifications as per required in NBL Division 1, NBL Division 2 & WNBL. If there is no Head / Assistant Coach coaching the team during a particular match, the match will be regarded as a walk-over.**

SUMMARY OF NCAP COURSES CONDUCTED BY SSC & BAS FOR 2009 (ANNEX B)

The following NCAP courses (Theory) by SSC will be conducted at the following dates of 2009:

- NCAP Level 1 (Theory) at SSC – **12 January 2009 to 6 February 2009**
- NCAP Level 2 (Theory) at SSC – **3 March 2009 to 7 April 2009**
- NCAP Level 3 (Theory) at SSC – **13 April 2009 to 15 May 2009**

Upon the releasing of the schedule for the NCAP (Theory) courses for the next half year of 2009, BAS will e-mail to the coaches of the respective teams informing them of the schedule.

The following NCAP courses (Technical) by BAS will be conducted at the following months of 2009:

- NCAP Level 1 (Theory & Technical) at BAS – **February to March 2009**
- NCAP Level 1 (Theory & Technical) at BAS – **November to December 2009**
- NCAP Level 2 (Theory & Technical) at BAS – **May to June 2009**
- NCAP Level 3 (Technical) at BAS – **August to September 2009**

There will be 2 First-Aid courses conducted in conjunction with the NCAP Level 1 (Theory & Technical) coaching courses. The dates of the First-Aid courses are in **March 2009 & December 2009**.
