

## Singapore Coach Excellence (SG-Coach) Level 1 Integrated Course (Basketball)

SG-Coach Level 1 Integrated Course (Basketball) By Basketball Association of Singapore (BAS) is the first level of coaching qualification for those who wish to commit to coaching the sport. The course provides each learning coach with a basic knowledge of basketball and the coaching skills necessary.

<p><b>How is the course structured?</b></p> <p>The course will be conducted in English. It will be very interactive and involves group discussion, presentation and application of the theory in practical context. There will be a minimal amount of coursework to do in preparation for the taught sessions.</p> <p>The whole qualification is designed to be a mixture of tutor-delivered theory, practical sessions and online self-study. The qualification places appropriate emphasis on the practical aspects of the role of the coach.</p> <p>The tutor-delivered element of the course will take place over 11 sessions of 3 hours each and includes a mixture of both theory and practical task.</p> <p>Practical involvement: Participants must be in sports attire with court shoes. You will be encouraged to participate practically to maximize your opportunities for learning.</p>	<p><b>How will I be accessed?</b></p> <p>In order to achieve the qualification, you will be assessed in the following areas: written assessment, on-court practical coaching assessment. You must also attend 80% of the all the course sessions. (Values and Principles in Sports module is a compulsory session)</p> <p>For Practical assessment, you will need to deliver a pre-planned 10-minute individual skill session and a 20-minute team skill coaching session to a small group of other learners on the course or players provided by BAS. (You will be informed of the skills that you will be required to coach for the assessment).</p> <p>You will be required to undertake a 2 days voluntary coaching attachment with Active SG Academy as part of the mentoring program. (9 hours)</p>
<p><b>What are the pre requisites of the course?</b></p> <p>To be eligible to attend the course, you must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be 18 years of age or older and medically fit.</li> <li>• Preferably but not required to have previous experience of playing basketball or be able to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the theory and practice of playing basketball.</li> </ul>	<p><b>When, where and cost of the course?</b></p> <p>The course will be conducted at Singapore Basketball Centre (601 Aljunied Crescent #01-04, Singapore 389862).</p> <p>The course will be in the last quarter of 2017.</p> <p>The cost will be \$600 to be paid by cash or cheque to BAS.</p>
<p><b>What will I be qualified to do?</b></p> <p>Upon successful completion of the course, the participant will receive the SG-Coach Integrated Level 1 (Basketball) certificate jointly issued by Sport Singapore and Basketball Association of Singapore (BAS). You will be qualified as a SG-Coach Level 1 Basketball coach and be able to conduct coaching sessions in clubs and schools (NROC required).</p>	<p><b>What could I do next?</b></p> <p>Coaches are encouraged to enroll in the National Registry of Coaches (NROC) after completion of the course. SG-Coach Level 1 coach may be able to gain paid or voluntary employment as a coach for club teams, school teams, children and young people. In addition, you could use the course as a pathway to progress to the SG-Coach Level 2 Certificate in coaching basketball.</p>
<p><b>What is the registration process?</b></p> <p>Participants are required to complete a pre-course questionnaire to help us to ensure that you would get the most out of the course. The questionnaire will determine which class you attend.</p> <p>Registration is only confirmed upon completion of questionnaire and full payment of the court fees.</p> <p>Class size shall not be more than <b>25</b> individuals.</p> <p>Based on the experience of the participant places are allocated to maximize the participant's learning as well as a first-come-first served basis.</p>	<p><b>How do I register the course and obtain further information?</b></p> <p>Should you require further clarifications, please contact Mr. Paul Ng at 6743 8425 or email him at paulng@bas.org.sg</p>
